enzyme that catalyzes the reversible formation of acetoacetyl-CoA from two molecules of acetyl-CoA.


Defects in this gene are associated with 3-ketothiolase deficiency, an inborn error of






Western Blot analysis of various cells using ACAT-1 Polyclonal Antibody


